#### 08.06.17.02 MAINTENANCE ISSUES FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS

<u>Sanitary bins</u> – Signage placed in family room re not using for nappies to assist with the issue of becoming full. Will need to monitor to see if still filling up between services.

Four (4) weekly supply and servicing of sanitary bins costs \$179 per bin – so to place a sanitary bin in all the toilet stalls at the pavilion at the same interval (4 weeks) will be an additional \$11,635 per annum. Currently one in each change-room, the ladies toilet, and the disabled toilet.

Cliff will provide details of a cheaper alternative system.

Investigate putting a bin in the changerooms for nappies. To be removed by user at end of each use as per conditions of use.

Sign in family change to be moved next to the changetable, not the toilet.

Clubs have an historical allocation to the spaces within the shed.


Clubs wishing to share/change need to contact the relevant club and make arrangements.


